




OUR MISSION & VISION

Mission: To support BIPOC farmers and landowners in rural Eastern North Carolina with tools for sustainable agriculture and economic resilience.


Vision: To support a thriving, equitable agricultural community where BIPOC and stewards and others have access to the resources and opportunities they deserve.





YEAR AT A GLANCE

- 35 Technical Assistance and Outreach consultations w/Farmers, Landowners and students
- 16 events hosted
- 40 in-person learning events attended
- 37 virtual trainings and workshops attended





GROWING OUR REACH

F.A.R.M. hosted 16 workshops and community gatherings in 2025, ranging from hands on gardening and repair workshop to mental wellness in agriculture and CPR trainings. Highlights include:

- Cousins' Camp: A family-focused youth learning day introducing the next generation to sustainable farming and forest practices.
- Cultivating Communities: A F.A.R.M. Resource Gathering: Our nonprofit's official launch event drew 40+ attendees and brought together USDA, Extension, and service providers with landowners and beginning farmers.
- Mental Health in Agriculture Workshop : Hosted in partnership with NC Agromedicine Institute and Gratitude Farm & Retreat, this event emphasized stress management, wellness tools, and community care in farming.

PRESERVING LEGACY: HEIRS PROPERTY AND BEYOND

In December 2025, F.A.R.M. hosted a powerful workshop on heirs property and land legacy, followed by a screening of the documentary Family Tree. The session offered legal education, emotional grounding, and networking opportunities for dozens of landowners. A moderated panel featuring experts and those with lived experience, including F.A.R.M. board member Nikki Jefferies, helped participants feel both informed and empowered.






LOOKING AHEAD
